Program Structure

LearningQUEST offers an environment for inquiring minds; stimulating courses in a variety of academic disciplines; affordable, centrally located day-time programs; enrichment activities; planned trips; and fellowship in a warm, welcoming atmosphere. No homework/no tests.

LearningQUEST has two terms of five months each year:

- Winter/Spring (Jan – May)
- Summer/Fall (July – Nov)

Each term begins with a Rally Day which is open to the public.

Rally Day kicks off the term with an interesting speaker, membership sign-up, and the term catalog of programs plus members have the opportunity to register for their choice of courses.

LearningQUEST programs are generally held in the Main Library's meeting spaces at 915 Monroe Street near downtown Huntsville.
