How to apply

You may submit in any written form (letter, pictures, infographic, combo of all, etc.) a proposal to operate your business inside the new library. Your proposal must address ALL the following points:

- full sample menu of offerings, including prices
- commitment to operate during all open hours of the library
- proposed contract agreement outlining your vision for either paying rent to the library, paying a percentage of earnings, a combination, or a new concept for how to create a legal/financial partnership
- items/furnishings/build-out requests you may require
- include your current business revenue estimates for the past six months

Information

- the public area of the coffee shop will be approximately 990 square feet; the entire shop including kitchen area will be approximately 1300 square feet
- outdoor seating is available on a patio outside coffee shop
- patrons are allowed to bring food/drinks with them anywhere inside/outside the library
- there will be a refrigerated display cabinet at the sales counter
- kitchen will include: sink, ice maker, rack, refrigerator, hand wash sink, dish wash sink, work table, double door refrigerator, freezer, three bowl sink, tile flooring
- coffee shop will include a walk-up window accessible from outside the building
- library hours tentatively set for: M-Th, 9a-8p; F-Sa, 9a-5p; Su 1-5p
