
Sculpture Competition

- Accepting Submission Ideas January 1-February 1 2017.
- Final Sculpture must be completed no later than April 15, 2017.

Space specifications: space is recessed 7"-7.5"



Materials: Most all materials are welcome, but require pre-approval. <u>All submissions mustinclude books</u>, in some fashion, within or as a part of the artwork.

Budget: The library will donate \$200 for project materials. The Library will also supply discarded books for use in the project.

Submissions:

- Submissions must be made in writing. Submissions are to be handed to the Circulation Desk at the Downtown Huntsville Library.
- They should include all pertinent information such as: artist name and contact information, materials to be used, expected cost of materials, time line for project completion, number of individuals who will work on the project, and any other information that would be useful for the library to be aware of.
- Sketches, drawings or photographs of the intended project are preferred.
- Evidence of previous completed projects is advantageous to being selected.

Selection Process: The project committee will select a winner from among the submissions by February 15 and the artist will be notified. Upon selection, the artist will be able to create their new artwork as a semi-permanent display at that Downtown Huntsville Library to be debuted at this location's 30th anniversary celebration. A plaque naming the artist will be provided for the artwork.

Project Ownership: Upon completion, the sculpture/artwork and its entirety becomes the property of the Huntsville-Madison County Public Library, who may do with it whatever it

deems necessary for the library which includes length of display time and determination of dismantling or removal.
