



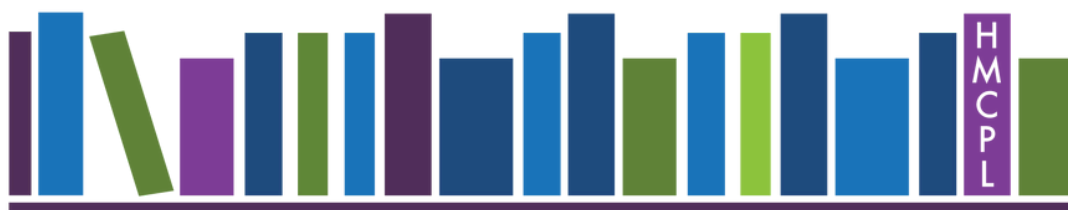

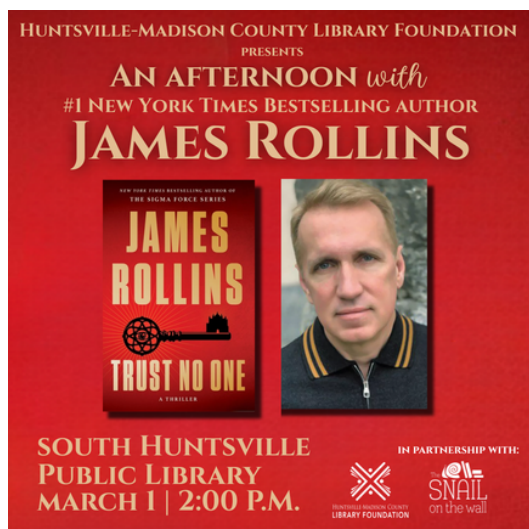
An Evening with Rachel Hawkins
