Phase Two of HMCPL's reopening plan to go into effect June 1

Huntsville, Ala. (June 1, 2020) - The Huntsville-Madison County Public Library (HMCPL) will begin offering public computer access by appointment, mobile printing as well as expanded curbside hours beginning on June 1.

- Public computers will be available for appointment only at all locations except Cavalry Hill, from 12:00 p.m. until 4:00 p.m., Monday-Friday. Downtown, Bailey Cove and Madison will also have Saturday appointments available from 12:00 p.m. until 4:00 p.m.
- To schedule an appointment, call your local branch.
- Appointments are for 45 minutes max.
- Mobile printing is also available. Exact change or payment by check only. Visit our mobile printing site for more information.
- Cavalry Hill branch remains closed due to building access restrictions. However, the Bookmobile will be on site every Tuesday beginning June 2 from 2:30 p.m. -4:30 p.m. to distribute summer reading materials and accept book returns.

HMCPL began curbside service at 10 of its 11 locations on May 6. The new hours for curbside will be:

- Monday Saturday from 10:00 a.m to 5:00 p.m. at Downtown, Madison, and Bailey Cove
- Monday Friday from 10:00 a.m to 5:00 p.m. at Monrovia, Murphy, Hazel Green, Triana and Showers
- Monday Friday from 12:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. at Gurley and New Hope

Phase three of our reopening plan will be announced at a later date and that will include open hours for patrons with capacity restrictions.
