

Kids Zone exists to empower parents in shepherding their child's faith in God.

Kids Zone will provide a Pentecost Experience for children 3-8 years old. It will open one hour before the main service begins and will remain open until all kids have been reunited with their parents.

All kids will be required to be registered. Pre-registration is encouraged. The deadline for pre-registration is May 31. Sequentially numbered wrist bands will be placed on each kid (with number, name and cell phone number of parent) and the matching numbered stub will be given to the parent/guardian. The stub and wrist bands will be matched at the time the kid is released. Kids will be grouped by age, 3-4, 5-6, 7-8. There will be at least one adult and one young adult per group.

Adults and mature teen YPDers will serve as attendants. At least one attendant per 10 children will be required. Kids will be assigned to an attendant based on age. Kids who have not preregistered will not be accepted once the capacity/ratio is met. All attendants must submit to a background check.

For those who are physically and medically able, please join us in a 1-meal per day Daniel Fast. The suggested Bible readings are to be read daily, meditated upon, preached and/or studied.

May 29, 2014: Pray for 24,000 persons in attendance
